On June 15th, we are having a planning meeting for those who are interested in the Tornado Relief Mission Trip in July. The mission trip is scheduled for July 11 to July 18.



Back in December, there were a series of tornados that hit the Diocese of Owensboro. Through Catholic Charities, FEMA, and other government agencies, those whose homes and businesses were affected were relocated to safety. Since then, the infrastructure was rebuilt and the materials for rebuilding have been delivered. This June, people have returned to their homes, though there is still a need for much work. That is where we get involved.

Our primary goal is to gain experience as Missionary Disciples who are ready to jump into action, as representatives of the Catholic Church, with any crisis or serious needs of the future. We will develop skills for organizing relief efforts, the collection of data, the physical help with reconstruction, and the personal witness of God's love. In essence, we evangelize by loving those most in need. Our example and efforts give testimony to the dignity of those we help and the command of our Lord to love our neighbor as ourselves.

We will be joining other "Missionary Disciples-in training" from other parishes of our diocese. At the June 15th meeting, we will discuss what it means to represent our church and how we expect to reach our goals while offering the most help as possible.



It is time for us to recruit some Missionary Disciples for a trip to Kentucky to help provided relief from the 2021 tornado damage

We are putting together a group of 25 people to go from July 11 to July 18 on this mission trip. Participants must be 21 years old and up. Participants must be active Catholics willing to be trained as Missionary Disciples for future efforts sponsored by the Diocese of Cleveland. The trip will cost \$100 per person and includes food and lodging.

The tasks will include door-to-door surveys of the needs of people, painting, some demolition and house repairs, and potentially working with children while the parents are rebuilding their homes.

The purpose of the trip is to form a group of Catholics across the diocese who are experienced in organizing relief mission trips. These "Missionary Disciples" will be ready to help and organize others in the event of future crisis. It is important to have people caring for people so as to spread the message of Christ's love. The act of helping others is uplifting for those developing their spiritual identity as Catholics. The more opportunities people have to live their Faith, the healthier the Church becomes. We will be the ones offering these opportunities.


We are inviting those who may be interested to an informational meeting on June 15th at 6:30 PM.
